



DIFFERENT VIEWS OFFERED BY THE OCULI OPENING THE NEW TOPOGRAPHY

THE PEOPLE WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO APPROPRIATE THE NEW ORGANIC LAYERS WITH CONSTRUCTIONS INSPIRED BY SHIGERU BAN'S HUMANITARIAN ARCHI-TECTURE. THIS UTOPIAN POSSIBILITY OF CREATING AND CONSTANTLY RENEWING EPHEMERAL VILLAGES WITH ONLY RECYCLED WOODEN STICKS AND FLEXIBLE JUNC-TIONS EMPHASIZES A RETURN TOWARDS A MORE PRIMITIVE LIFESTYLE AND CONSTRUCTION METHODS. THESE SHELTERS ORIGINALLY INFLUENCED BY FULLER'S GEODESIC DOME CAN BE INTERPRETED BY THE PEOPLE WHOM WILL EXPERIENCE IN A LUDIC WAY ARCHITECTURE AND WILL BE ABLE TO BUILD A FORM TO THEIR LIKING. THEIR PARTICIPATION IN BUILDING THESE STRUCTURES AND MAKING THEM EVOLVE WILL REINTRODUCE THE SENSE OF SMALL INDIVIDUAL ISLANDS GROUPED IN AN AR-CHIPELAGO VIA THE REPETITION OF CELLULAR UNITS ABOVE AND BELOW THE CONCRETE INTERVENTION. IF THE GOAL OF THE ORGANIC COATING WAS TO UNITE THE ISLANDS, THESE STRUCTURE WILL RESPOND WITH THE POSSIBILITY OF CREATING OUR OWN PERSONAL ISLANDS WITH RANDOM LOCATIONS AS A UTOPIAN COLLECTIVE UNITY. HENCE, WE OBSERVE A DICHOTOMY BETWEEN THE UNIFYING LARGER CONCRETE INTERVENTION AND THESE SMALL SHELTERS.
